

Camp Deerpark  
A Time to Build (ATTB) Construction Assistant  
Job Description

Requirements:

High school graduate age 18-25  
General maintenance skills and a willingness to learn

Supervision:

The ATTB Construction Assistant will come under the direct supervision of the ATTB Building Supervisor, for job assignments, instruction, and evaluation.

Tasks: (For the most part these are written in the order in which they will be completed)

- Helping with the operation of the Portable Sawmill
  - Organizing and Stacking Lumber
  - Managing Sawmill Drop (making firewood and wood chips)
  - Organizing Logs in the field
- Helping with Site Preparation
  - Clearing Trees
  - Installing Sewer System (Lines, Tanks, Beds)
  - Installing Water System
  - Building Roads
  - Installing Storm Water Controls
- Transforming the old pool “llama lake” into a aesthetically pleasing and functional pond. (building a larger dam, addition of a dock and boat house)
- Construction of Well House for water system
- Foundation Preparation for Summer Camp Cabins
- Construction of Summer Camper Cabins (Concrete, block, conventional framing, timber framed roof structure)
- Construction of Summer Staff Cabins (different floor plan but similar construction to above Summer Camper Cabins)
- Building furniture for the Cabins (bunk beds, tables, cubbies, etc.)
- Development of Ball Fields
- Construction of Playgrounds
- Foundation Preparation for the Program Center
- Construction of Program Center (Dinning hall, meeting room, kitchen, bathrooms: more of a commercial building)
- In addition to using hand tools and power tools, there will be the opportunity to learn and operate many different machines depending on our needs and your prior experience, aptitude, and performance at camp
- Depending on the number of ATTB Construction Assistants, availability of equipment and materials, and procurement of funds, there may be times when we work on general maintenance or ATTB projects outside the scope of the summer camp village project.
