Space for growth hosts learning new things in community with your team.



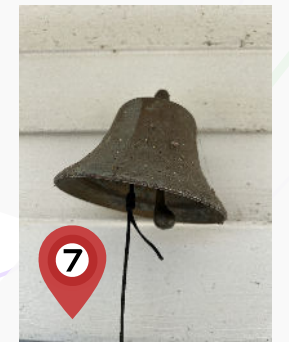
MISSION

irreversible **rebirth** into a new **reality**



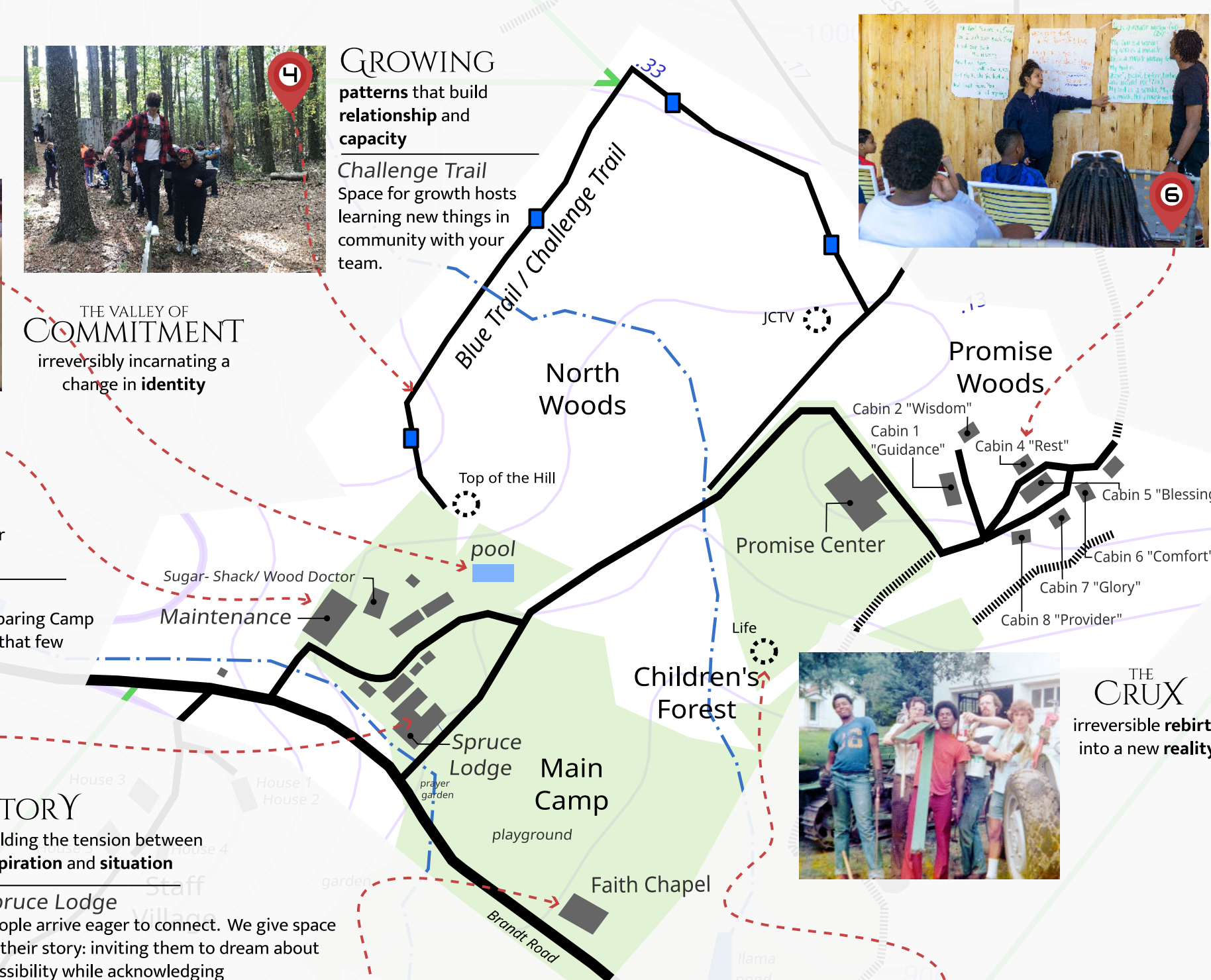
REVELATION

The JOURNEY MAP?

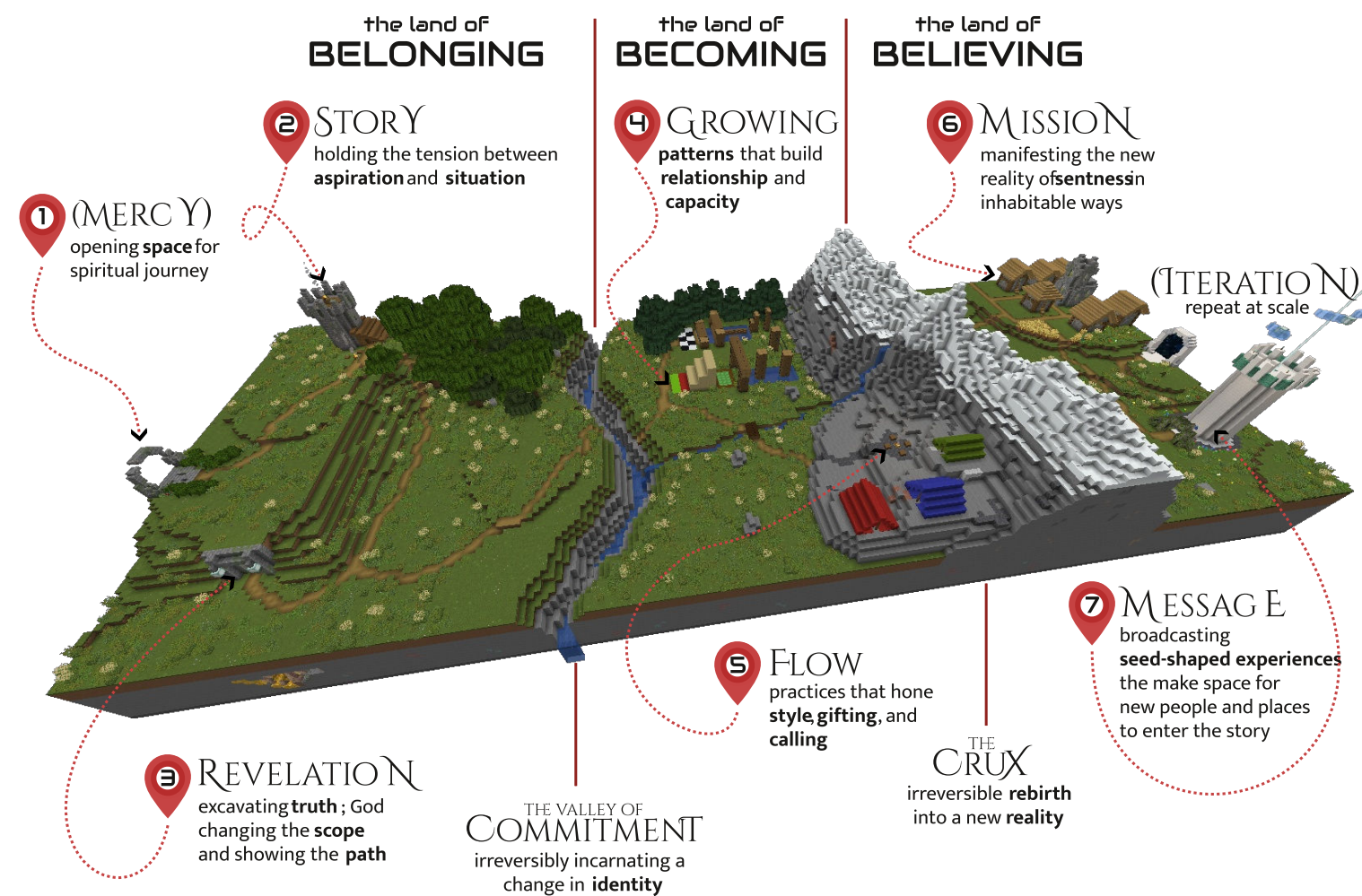
The Journey Map is an allegorical framework for Discipleship-Through-Mission that helps **groups** and **individuals**:

- 📍 **position** themselves on their spiritual journey
- 📍 **discern** what actions are critical
- 📍 **learn** and practice essential skills
- 📍 **manage** change towards greater incarnation of Jesus and manifestation of his Kingdom both inwardly into our souls and outwardly into the world.

The movement dynamics of the framework -- appropriate to use for community change in churches, mission groups, church planting, and enterprises -- are based on a systematic psycho-social understanding of the broad movements of God and actions of Jesus in the Gospel of Luke and Early Acts of the Apostles. In other words, it's built on the idea that we should base human transformation on the Master who transformed our humanity.

The interpersonal dynamics of the framework, for use in leadership development, personal growth, and discipleship, are based on a broader reading of the interpersonal teachings and methods of Jesus and his followers across the New Testament. This has been allegorically matched with real missions experiences in discipleship and people development in diverse contexts: multi-cultural, transcultural, intergenerational, urban, suburban, and rural. As an allegorical framework based on sustainable spiritual geometries, The Journey Map serves also as a platform for innovation and experimentation for further contextualization.
