# [5] MISSIONAL INTERCESSION

## STEP 1

Pray as a team for 20 min or longer to join Jesus in his role as intercessor in heaven. Focus prayer on the blood of Jesus and the team's willingness to follow him and join him in his love, service, and sacrifice for people.

## STEP 2

Each person on the team will look at the three roles: apostle, prophet, and shepherd. Which is most comfortable and attractive for you? This is what you will see, discern, and equip as a team during 10-30 min of individual prayer and contemplation.

## STEP 3

Come together as a team and debrief on what was seen and discerned. Work together to form a plan to carry out what the Lord is revealing. Pray further on anything that seems unclear. Use word, insight, and strategy to equip the team to execute on God's revealed will. Deploy in teams of at least two to complete the mission and return to pray and offer thanksgiving.

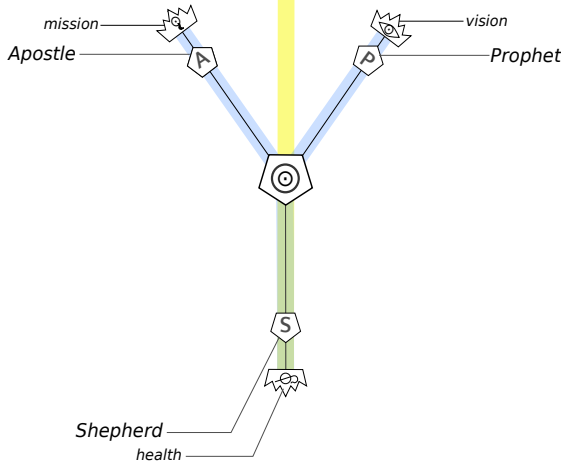


### JESUS | Rom 8:38

### FOUR TYPES of PRAYER | 1 Tim 2:2-7

First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time. For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying), a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

**supplication:** needs-based prayer

**prayer (proseuche):** fervent prayer concerning deep desires

**intercession:** lit. prayer that "goes between"; missional prayer

**thanksgivings:** prayers of praise and thankfulness
